
Alison Roberts

Alison grew up dancing and performing in Victoria BC. She is a graduate of the Canadian College of Performing Arts, the Harbour Dance Center Intensive Training Program, and the Banff/Citadel Professional Theatre Program. She also holds a BFA and a Minor in Business with Distinction from the University of Victoria.

Her select theatrical credits include *West Side Story* (Vancouver Opera, Rainbow Stage, Citadel Theatre), *Spamalot* (Arts Club), *Beauty and the Beast* (Arts Club), *Crazy for You* (Theatre Calgary, Citadel Theatre), Mamma Mia (Citadel Theatre), and *Singing in the Rain* (Capitol Theatre). Alison is also an experienced vocalist with over a decade of professional experience including singing onstage with Josh Groban and Kenny Rogers. Alison has also worked on various film and TV projects, including *The Waltz*, a featured selection in the Toronto Short Film Festival and *That Man*, the winner of Dance Magazines Video of the Month.

In 2018, Alison shifted her focus from performing and began exploring her other artistic passions. Currently, Alison works at the Canadian College of Performing Arts in student support, events and productions. She also works as a freelance choreographer and director with various companies and studios throughout BC. Recent credits include *Mamma Mia!*, *Beauty and the Beast* (VOS), *Classic Country Roads* (Chemainus) and *Spring Awakening* (Phoenix Theatre).

After being a BC Provincial competitor herself over a decade ago in stage, ballet, and musical theatre, Alison is thrilled to be back teaching these workshops and sharing her passion for theatre jazz with all the aspiring performers.
